



#### **EXPENSES V. REVENUE YEAR OVER YEAR**





Nikki passed away from cancer at far too young an age, but her positive impact on all our lives at One Step Beyond will continue to live on.

Over the past year, we have set the ground work to develop our residential community and will continue to build upon that framework in the oncoming year.
